kinship	a feeling of being close or connected to other people (<i>n</i>)
hurtle	to move rapidly and forcefully; fling (<i>v</i>)
dredge	to dig, gather, or pull out; to deepen (as a waterway) (<i>v</i>)
cremate	To reduce (as a dead body) to ashes by burning (<i>v</i>)
relentlessly	showing no promise of stopping in severity, intensity, strength, or pace; unrelenting (<i>adv</i>)
rhythmic	moving in pronounced rhythm (<i>adj</i>)
mourning	the act of sorrowing; an outward sign of grief for a person's death (<i>n</i>)
gully	a trench which was originally worn in the earth by running water and through which water often runs after rain; a small valley or gulch (<i>n</i>)
commend	to recommend as worthy of confidence or notice; to mention with praise (<i>v</i>)
piteous	with pity or compassion (<i>adj</i>)
